

PRESEASON PREPARATION

Proper vehicle preparation is necessary after the winter months or when a watercraft has not been used during 4 months.

Any worn, broken or damaged parts found must be replaced.

Using the *MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE*, perform the items titled *EVERY 100 HOURS OR 1 YEAR*.

EVERY 100 HOURS OR 1 YEAR
Replace engine oil and filter
Inspect engine rubber mounts
Spray an anticorrosion lubricant to metallic components in engine compartment (every 10 hours in salt water use)
Inspect and flush the exhaust system
Inspect the cooling system (coolant level, hoses and fasteners for leaks)
Lubricate and verify the ITC lever for proper operation (Depress and release the lever to check for freedom of movement. If any friction is felt, the lever must be taken apart, cleaned, inspected for wear and lubricated)
Inspect fuel cap, filler neck, fuel tank, fuel tank straps, fuel lines and connections (At storage period or after 100 hours of use whichever comes first)
Test the fuel system for leaks
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Furthermore, proceed with the following:

Watercraft Prepared as per Storage Procedure

- Ensure battery is fully charged.
- Reinstall the battery.
- Test ride watercraft to confirm proper operation.

Watercraft Not Prepared as per Storage Procedure

- Ensure battery is fully charged.
- Replace engine oil and filter.
- Drain fuel tank and fill with fresh fuel.
- Reinstall the battery.
- Test ride watercraft to confirm proper operation.
